- All Persimmon Cup Qualifiers team up to represent Whitetail Ridge vs Old Oak CC

#### **Rules and Regulations**

Season Long Race for Persimmon Cup: Men's Club Players will compete in a season long race for the "Persimmon Cup". Qualifying points will be awarded after each event based on the total number of entries. Men's Club Players must play in a minimum of 6 events that will be counted for in the season long race. All Majors must be played. If you choose to play in more events, you can drop your worst performance in any event *EXCLUDING MAJORS*. The top 32-40 performers will be selected to play in the Persimmon Cup event. All Persimmon Cup qualifiers will represent the Club vs Old Oak.

Scoring/Rules: Since event rounds can be played on your own time, you MUST declare your round to the Golf Shop prior to teeing off. Golf Staff will provide an official scorecard to be used for each event. All scorecards must be signed/attested and dated, in clear and legible writing. Scorecards must be physically turned into Golf Shop Staff after completion of your round. A clear image must also be taken of the scorecard and emailed to our Scoring Staff for records. Players may be disqualified from points and winnings for an event if any of the following are missing or illegible: Full Names, tees used, date played. Your handicap is indicative of the tee box being used per player. If an individual handicap is out of norm the committee will provide appropriate corrections.

**Events:** For most events, Men's Club members will play in their own permanent or reservation tee time. Official Event Rounds **MUST** be declared to the Golf Shop prior to teeing off. All events will have a \$10-20 sign-up fee, as well as a discounted rate for the golf. Men's Club members will be given 1 to 4 weeks depending on the event, to complete their round. Some events only require a Pro Pick by a certain date. All rounds must be played with at least 1 other member of the Men's Club.

Requirements to compete: All competitors must register for the 2023 Men's Club via registration form and provide payment to the Golf Shop. A CDGA handicap is required to compete. Most events will be played in your own tee time in a 1 to 4 week event period. Advanced sign-up is necessary for certain team events. Any event without dedicated tee assignments must be played from the Blue Tees. Seniors above 60 may play Gold. All playing handicaps will be calculated by the tees used.

**Prizes:** Points will be awarded after each event for our Season Long Race to the Persimmon Cup. Golf Shop Credits will also be awarded based on the number of entries for each event. Credits won may be applied towards any golf related purchases (ie: greens fees, merchandise, club events, ect.)

# 2023 Event Schedule

April 6 <sup>th -</sup> 30 <sup>th</sup>	Major Championship: THE MASTERS - Blind Draw (4 players and 1 alternate player/number) + Low Net (Lowest Score Wins) Must select numbers/players by April 6 <sup>th</sup> !!!!!. Pick 4 numbers 1-100 and 1 alternate number/player, the numbers you pick will represent different players. Event sign-up fee: \$20 (200pts)						
May 1 <sup>st</sup> – 19 <sup>th</sup>	<b>Two-man Mixer:</b> Simply declare your round to the Golf Shop prior to teeing off to receive event score card. We will randomly pair you with another player in the Men's Club for a T Man Low Net Score. <b>Event sign-up fee: \$10 each (100pts)</b>						
May 20 <sup>th</sup> – 31 <sup>st</sup>	Major Championship: PGA CHAMPIONSHIP - Play with Pro Best Ball (Net Score) vs their real score Per Hole. (Pick Player before Hand) Event sign-up fee: \$20 (200pts)						
June 1 <sup>st</sup> – 15 <sup>th</sup>	3 Club Challenge: Players will be allowed 3 clubs of their choice plus a putter to compete handicapped stroke play tournament. Event sign-up fee: \$10 (100pts)						
June 16 <sup>th</sup> – 30 <sup>th</sup>	Major Championship: U.S. OPEN – Individual Low Net. Event sign-up fee: \$20 (200pts)						
July 1 <sup>st</sup> – 13 <sup>th</sup>	Two-Man Scramble: Players will compete with a teammate of their choosing in a two-man scramble vs the rest of the men's club players. (Men's Club Only) Event sign-up fee: \$10 each (100pts)						
July 14 <sup>th</sup> – 29 <sup>th</sup>	Major Championship: THE OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP — Player will compete in a quota Stableford event. Quotas are determined of player's current handicap. Event sign-up fee: \$20 (200pts)						
August 1st – August 25th	One-Man Scramble: Players will play in an individual scramble where one is allowed one mulligan per hole. (Must still play with another member in the Men's Club.) Event Sign-up Fee: \$10 (100pts)						
August 26th – September 17 <sup>th</sup>	Pick your Tee Box Net Score: Play from any Tee Box on the course and your index will be adjusted accordingly. Lowest net score wins!  Event Sign-Up Fee: \$10 (100pts)						
September 23rd	<b>PERSIMMON CUP:</b> The two top preforming players will be team captains and pick their teammates. The top 32-40 players automatically qualify into the Persimmon Cup (Including captains). Each Captain will be allowed two captain picks each. <b>Red Team</b> Vs. <b>Blue Team.</b>						
OCT. 7th-8th	Whitetail Ridge GC vs OLD OAK GC Cup: Both, Red Team and Blue Team will qualify to play in this exclusive event. It will be Whitetail Ridge's Men's Club vs Old Oaks Men's Club in a battle for the Club Cup! Team Captains for this event will be the Club Professionals.  Day 1 is at Whitetail Ridge GC and Day 2 is at Old Oak GC. LET'S WIN THE TROPHY!!
